Welcome Center

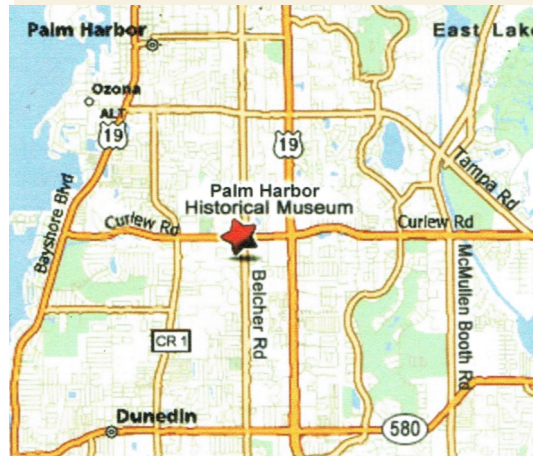
The Museum is a Welcome Center for Palm Harbor and Pinellas County. Obtain brochures and discount coupons to Florida attractions.

From **east**, take Hillsborough Ave/ Tampa Rd west to Belcher Rd, turn south to Curlew.

From **north**, take US 19 south to Curlew, turn right, go to Belcher. The Museum entrance is on Curlew, just west of Belcher.

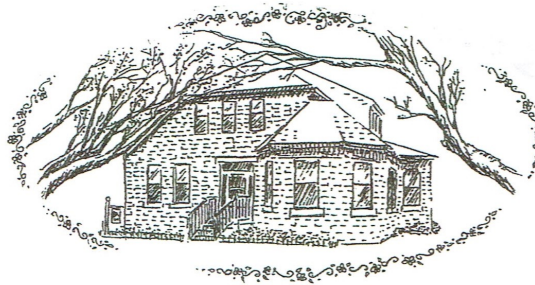
Our Museum
